# Coloring Book Art from Photos II

**Step 1.** Grab an image that you wish to manipulate and you can begin. This is a photo from the internet. You should use one of you own.



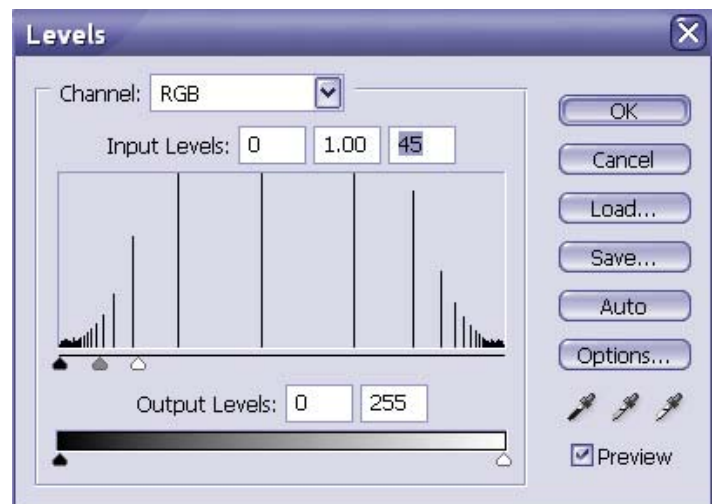
**Step 2.** After you have an image go to the top main menu bar and select "Filter" then "Other" and lastly "High Pass" Put 6.4 as the setting and click "OK".



**Step 3.** Now go to the main menu bar once again and this time go to "Image" then "Adjustments" then "Equalize." Select the entire image option.



**Step 4.** Go to the main menu and click on "Image" > "Adjustments" then select "Levels" and use the below settings.



**Step 5.** You should now have the this image:



**Step 6.** Lastly, go to "Image" then "Mode" and select "Greyscale" and click "OK." Be sure to clean up any blemishes and save as a different filename and your done.



**The Results!!!**

**Step 7.** (Optional) If you are not totally satisfied with the tones or darkness of the lines, etc. you may want take the image a step farther by revisiting levels and adjusting the shadow and midtone sliders to enhance all or portions of your image. When you are nearly satisfied, click OK. You can do this process several times to darken your lines in selected areas by using the Magic Wand or (better) the Quick Selection Tool to control the areas affected by this optional step (see below).



After one levels pass to entire photo



After selecting just the jacket and making another levels adjustment pass.
